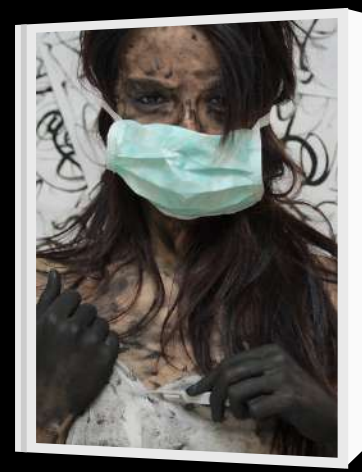

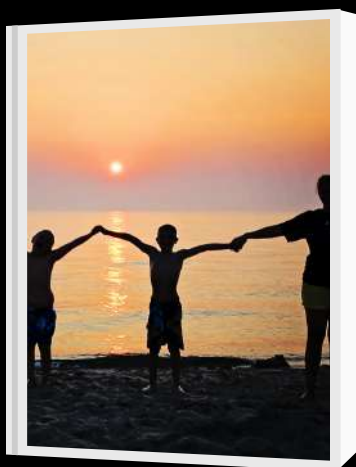
The aim for The Innovators Board is to be implementors of more purposeful societies, better futures for all and a better world.

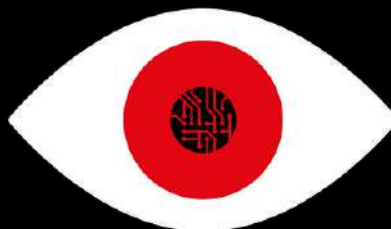

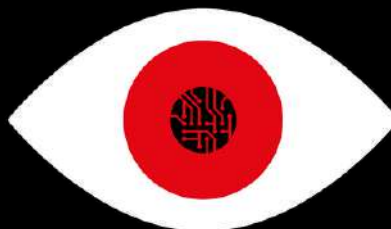
